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Randy,

The waterline is 15 feet to the right of the street centerline. Pipe centerline is about 9.5 feet away from existing back of curb. The bulb-out moves the back of curb over about 6.5 feet. This places the pipe centerline approximately 3 feet from future back of curb. That leaves about 0.5 feet between lip of curb and pipe wall which matches the minimum clearance between pipe and trench wall per LVVWD plate 17. I am not too familiar with pipe design at bulb outs. Will this be enough, or will CLV/LVVWD be requiring additional clearance width?
