2 WHEREAS, LVMPD is committed to working with the Governor, State Legislature, local entities,
3 and other key stakeholders to extend the Property Tax Levy through July 1, 2057.


4 NOW, THEREFORE, BASED UPON THE FOREGOING, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY
5 COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS ("City Council") that the City Council expresses its continued
6 strong support of LVMPD, its programs and services, and to endorse its efforts in the 2025 Session of the
7 Nevada Legislature to extend the Property Tax Levy authorization; and

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council respectfully encourages the Governor, State
9 Legislature, other local jurisdictions, and key stakeholders to work together to find a mutually acceptable
10 method to extend the Property Tax Levy for the ultimate benefit of our local residents, our local economy,
11 and the tens of millions of annual tourists and visitors to our region.


12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval
13 and adoption.


