PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:
NRS 354.5982 authorizes the levy of a total rate of 28 cents on each \$100 of assessed valuation in the taxing district of the City of Las Vegas and unincorporated Clark County for the purposes of employing police officers with the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department. Of this total rate, 20 cents will expire on June 30, 2027, unless otherwise extended. This Resolution will express the City Council's support of the extension of this assessment to protect LVMPD staffing rates and to continue to provide high quality public safety services to the community.

8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council respectfully encourages the Governor, State
9 Legislature, other local jurisdictions, and key stakeholders to work together to find a mutually acceptable
10 method to extend the Property Tax Levy for the ultimate benefit of our local residents, our local economy,
11 and the tens of millions of annual tourists and visitors to our region.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon approval
13 and adoption.
