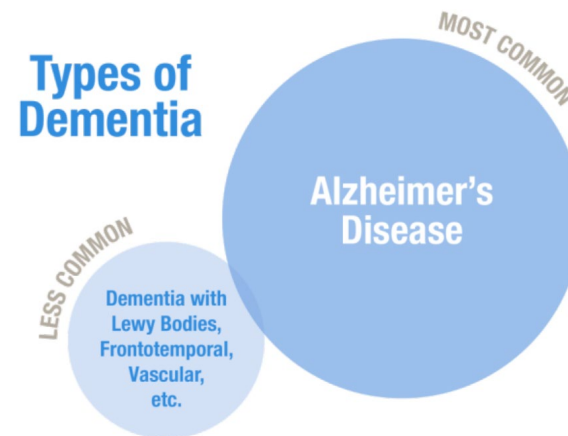


What is dementia?
