3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC 6.04.155 AND 6.69.010 TO UPDATE THE DEFINITIONS OF
4 THE BUSINESS LICENSE CATEGORIES “TRANSPORTATION NETWORK COMPANY” AND
5 “REFLEXOLOGY”, RESPECTIVELY, TO ALIGN WITH STATE LAW, AND PROVIDE FOR OTHER
6 RELATED MATTERS.

Summary: Amends LVMC 6.04.155 and 6.69.010
to update the definitions of the business licensing
categories “Transportation Network Company”
and “Reflexology”, respectively, to align with
8 State law.

9 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS
10 FOLLOWS:

11 SECTION 1: Title 6, Chapter 4, Section 155, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
12 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

13 **6.04.155:** Businesses within the following licensing category shall pay an annual license fee of
14 seventeen thousand five hundred dollars:

15 Transportation network company, which [is any business entity that uses a digital network or
16 software application service to connect a passenger to a driver who can provide transportation services to the
17 passenger as defined by NRS Title 58] has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS Chapter 706A. The fee is
18 intended to cover all company operations and no additional fee per-driver fee shall be imposed on the
19 company or any individual driver.

20 SECTION 2: Title 6, Chapter 69, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las
21 Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 **6.69.010:** Unless the context otherwise requires, the following words, as they appear in this Chapter,
23 shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this Section:

24 “Employee” means any person who performs reflexology as a bona fide employee of a reflexology business.

25 “Independent reflexologist” means a reflexologist who is not an employee of a reflexology establishment, is
26 a sole practitioner, and hires no employees.

1 “Outcall service” means reflexology given or provided off the premises of a licensed reflexology business.

2 “Reflexologist” means any person who, for consideration, engages in the practice of reflexology.

3 “Reflexology” [means a method of using the hands, thumbs or fingers to apply specific pressure to reflex
4 points located in the hands, feet or ears] has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS Chapter 640C.

5 “Reflexology establishment licensee practitioner” means the licensee of a reflexology establishment who
6 performs reflexology.

7 “Sexual activity” means:

8 (1) Sexual intercourse;

9 (2) Rubbing against a client for sexual gratification;

10 (3) Making sexual advances toward a client;

11 (4) Demanding or requesting sexual favors from a client;

12 (5) Kissing, hugging, touching, fondling or caressing of a sexual nature;

13 (6) Encouraging masturbation or any other sex act in the presence of a licensee or other person
14 performing reflexology;

15 (7) Masturbation or any other sex act by the licensee or other person performing reflexology;

16 (8) Suggesting or discussing the possibility of beginning a sexual relationship before the
17 professional relationship ends;

18 (9) Terminating the professional relationship with the client for the purpose of pursuing a sexual
19 relationship;

20 (10) Discussing the sexual history, preference or fantasies of the licensee or other person
21 performing reflexology;

22 (11) Any behavior, gesture or expression that may reasonably be interpreted as seductive or
23 sexual; or

24 (12) Showing a client sexually explicit photographs.

25 “Specified anatomical area” means:

26 (1) Genitals;

- 1 (2) Pubic region;
- 2 (3) Buttocks; or
- 3 (4) Female breast.

4 SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
5 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by
6 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the
7 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby
8 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase
9 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,
10 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

11 SECTION 4: Whenever in this ordinance any act is prohibited or is made or declared to
12 be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or whenever in this ordinance the doing of any act is required
13 or the failure to do any act is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, the doing of
14 such prohibited act or the failure to do any such required act shall constitute a misdemeanor and upon
15 conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for a term of
16 not more than six months, or by any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Any day of any violation
17 of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense.


