3 AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND LVMC 2.26.040 PERTAINING TO THE COMPENSATION FOR

Summary: Amends LVMC 2.26.040 to increase  
the compensation for alternate municipal judges  
from \$100.00 per session to \$150.00 per session.

7 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS  
8 FOLLOWS:

9 SECTION 1: Title 2, Chapter 26, Section 40, of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983  
10 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

11 **2.26.040:** (A) Alternate Municipal Judges in sufficient numbers shall be appointed yearly by the  
12 Mayor.

13 (B) An Alternate Judge shall possess the same qualifications required of the elected  
14 Municipal Court Judges and shall receive as compensation the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars for each  
15 session of the Court at which he or she presides. For purposes of this Subsection (B), a session of the Court  
16 includes a morning session, an afternoon session, or any other session as established and defined by judicial  
17 order.

18 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase  
19 in this ordinance or any part thereof is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by  
20 any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the  
21 remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof. The City Council of the City of Las Vegas hereby  
22 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase  
23 thereof irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs,  
24 sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

25 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances or sections, subsections, phrases,  
26 sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983

1 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.





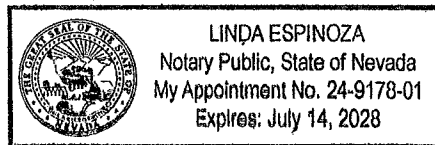
