

RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SUSTAINING LAS VEGAS 2050 ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City Council has previously adopted sustainability resolutions, including the Climate Protection Resolution (R-57-2006), Green Building Resolution (R-81-2006), Sustainable Energy Strategy (R-50-2008), Community Resilience, Net-Zero Energy, and Sustainability Resolution (R-32-2017), and Urban Forestry Program Resolution (R-43-2022) to make the City a nationwide leader in sustainability by establishing clear goals; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan (Ordinance 6788), a comprehensive thirty-year plan that considers a variety of near-term and long-term environmental and conservation topics, such as water, energy, waste, green buildings, emissions, alternative transportation, and urban forestry; and

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas has constructed numerous public works projects that have improved City operations and ensured cost savings, including LEED certified green buildings, solar photovoltaic systems, energy-efficient streetlighting and building improvements, turf conversions, electric vehicle charging stations, and tree plantings; and

WHEREAS, partnerships between governments, utility companies, and other public agencies allow the City to reduce its operational costs and ensure reliable water and clean energy supply for future generations through the removal of nonfunctional grass, reduction of consumptive water use, and creation of water waste reduction ordinances; and

WHEREAS, implementation of community programs derived from state policy have allowed both residents and commercial businesses of the City to benefit from community-based solar resources, water conservation rebates, and electric vehicle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the City has collaborated with other regional entities, including on the 'All-In Clark County' sustainability initiative, and the City is recognized for its leadership in sustainability as Gold Certified under the LEED for Cities certification program; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue momentum and capitalize on previous successes, sustainable planning efforts must continue to ensure the City, and community at large, attain outcomes that reduce energy

1 consumption and emissions, conserve water, recycle materials, and mitigate the urban heat island effect; and
2 WHEREAS, adoption of a new sustainability action plan will focus and guide new and previously
3 identified efforts contained within the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan that support and further short-
4 term and long-term implementation that will ultimately help the City reduce its environmental impact, reduce
5 municipal costs, and promote community health and safety.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS
7 VEGAS AS FOLLOWS:


- 8 1. The Sustaining Las Vegas 2050 Action Plan, attached to this Resolution, is hereby adopted. The
9 Sustaining Las Vegas 2050 Action Plan incorporates by reference the identified goals, outcomes, and
10 implementation strategies of the City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan which are relevant to water, energy
11 efficiency, waste reduction, alternative transportation, emissions, urban forestry, and hazard prevention.
- 12 2. The City's Chief Sustainability Officer and other designated staff shall, at the direction of the City
13 Manager, take necessary actions to advance the identified projects, policies, community programs, and
14 amendments to the Las Vegas Municipal Code, which implement the actions set forth in the Sustaining Las
15 Vegas 2050 Action Plan and City of Las Vegas 2050 Master Plan.
