

3. **Public Comment:** Comment during this portion of the agenda must be limited to matters on the agenda for action. If you wish to be heard, come forward and give your name for the record. The amount of discussion, as well as the amount of time any single speaker is allowed, may be limited.
4. For possible action to approve the Final Minutes by reference of the Regular Meeting of January 20, 2026
5. Discussion for possible action to establish Youth Leadership Advisory Council subcommittees, including confirmation of subcommittee scopes, assignment of members, and identification of initial deliverables
6. Discussion regarding establishing participation expectations and a meeting engagement structure to support effective member involvement during Youth Leadership Advisory Council meetings
7. Report by Youth as Solutions participants regarding current work group activities, priority focus areas, and youth-led recommendations
8. Discussion regarding the Youth Leadership Advisory Council's public outreach and engagement strategy, including coordination with City staff for appropriate communication channels
9. Discussion regarding finalizing Youth Leadership Advisory Council public outreach events

No subject may be acted upon by the Advisory Council unless that subject is on the agenda and is scheduled for action. If you wish to be heard, come forward and give your name for the record. The amount of discussion on any single subject, as well as the amount of time any single speaker is allowed, may be limited.
