

**RESOLUTION AND NOTICE REGARDING THE GRANTING TO
LIGHT SOURCE COMMUNICATIONS, LLC, OF A FRANCHISE FOR COMMUNICATIONS
SERVICES, INCLUDING BROADBAND INTERNET SERVICE, BROADBAND
INFRASTRUCTURE ACCESS AND/OR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE, SETTING THE
PURPOSE, CHARACTER, TERM AND CONDITIONS OF THE PROPOSED FRANCHISE
AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ADVISABILITY OF
GRANTING THE PROPOSED FRANCHISE**

WHEREAS, the City of Las Vegas (“City”), is desirous of providing its residents the opportunity to receive communications services, including broadband internet service, broadband infrastructure access and/or telecommunications service; and

WHEREAS, Light Source Communications, LLC (“Light Source”), a Michigan limited liability company, is authorized to do business in Nevada; and

WHEREAS, Light Source has requested the City to grant it a franchise permitting the installation, operation and maintenance of communications services, including broadband internet service, broadband infrastructure access and/or telecommunications service within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to ensure that the installation, operation and maintenance of such services within the corporate limits of the City is conducted in a manner which will not interfere with the public’s use of various rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, in response to Light Source’s request for franchise, a proposed Franchise Agreement between the City and Light Source has been prepared, granting the necessary permission and authority to Light Source to utilize the various rights-of-way, now or hereafter existing, for purposes of installing, operating and maintaining the services described above.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the requirements of Section 7.050 of the Las Vegas Charter, IT IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, as follows:

1. That Light Source has requested from the City that a franchise be granted to Light Source for the purpose of installing, operating and maintaining communications services, including broadband internet service, broadband infrastructure access and/or telecommunications service, within the corporate limits of the City.

1 2. That the purpose, character, terms, time and conditions of the franchise that the City proposes to
2 grant to Light Source, in response to Light Source's request to install, operate and maintain such services in,
3 upon, along, across, above, over and under the rights-of-way as defined by such franchise within the
4 corporate limits of the City, for a one-year period, are fully set forth in the proposed Franchise Agreement
5 on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, which proposed Franchise
6 Agreement is available for inspection by members of the public. For purposes of Section 7.050 of the City
7 Charter, the proposed Franchise Agreement is, by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part of this
8 Resolution and Notice.

9 3. That a public hearing be, and it hereby is, set for Wednesday, the 3rd day of June, 2026, in the City
10 Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, 495 South Main Street, Las Vegas, Nevada, at the hour of 9:30 a.m.,
11 for the purpose of hearing any objections or protests made by any person to the granting of a franchise to
12 Light Source pursuant to the proposed Franchise Agreement.

13 4. That all interested persons shall have, and they are hereby given, the right to appear and be heard on
14 the question of the advisability of granting a communications services franchise pursuant to the proposed
15 Franchise Agreement to Light Source at the place, date and hour specified for the public hearing in Paragraph
16 3 of this Resolution and Notice, or at any subsequent time to which said public hearing may be adjourned.


1 5. That the notice provided by this Resolution and Notice is reasonably calculated to inform each
