**RE: VAR-16996 - VARIANCE**

Dear Mr. Hellums:

Your request for a variance TO ALLOW A RESIDENTIAL PLANNED DEVELOPMENT OF 1.08 ACRES WHERE FIVE ACRES IS THE MINIMUM AREA REQUIRED on the north side of Smoke Ranch Road, approximately 467 feet east of Michael Way (APN 138-13-801-068), R-E (Residential Estates) Zone under Resolution of Intent to R-PD6 (Residential Planned Development - 6 Units per Acre), Ward 5 (Weekly), was considered by the Planning Commission on November 2, 2006.

The Planning Commission voted to recommend **APPROVAL** of your request, subject to the following:

### Planning and Development

1. Conformance to the conditions for Rezoning (ZON-16915), and Site Development Plan Review (SDR-16914) if approved.
2. This approval shall be void two years from the date of final approval, unless a certificate of occupancy has been issued or upon approval of a final inspection. An Extension of Time may be filed for consideration by the City of Las Vegas.

This item will be considered by the City Council on **December 6, 2006**, at 1:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 400 Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada. **The Council requires that you or your representative be present at this meeting.** If you or your representative chooses not to attend, the City Council may act in your absence without your input.
