

Ordinance No. 5042

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS AND WATER FEATURES; AMENDING TITLE 16, CHAPTER 30, SECTION 10, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO ADOPT BY REFERENCE THE 1997 EDITION OF THE SOUTHERN NEVADA POOL CODE; PROVIDING THAT SAID CODE REPLACES AND SUPERSEDES THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS SWIMMING POOL/SPA CODE, 1992 EDITION, EXCEPT AS TO PROCEDURAL AND ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The above and foregoing ordinance was first proposed and read by title to the City Council on the 24TH day of November, 1997, and referred to the following committee composed of Councilmen Brown and McDonald for recommendation; thereafter the said committee reported favorably on said ordinance on the 15th day of December, 1997, which was a regular meeting of said City Council; and that at said regular meeting the proposed ordinance was read by title to the City Council as first introduced and adopted by the following vote:
