ORDINANCE NO. 5111

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO POLICE SERVICE ANIMALS; AMENDING TITLE 7 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER TO PROVIDE PROTECTIONS FOR POLICE SERVICE ANIMALS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Establishes protections for police service animals.
