AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE ABATEMENT OF NUISANCES; AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 4, SECTION 20, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, 1983 EDITION, TO SPECIFICALLY EXEMPT CERTAIN PERSONS WHO HAVE EXERCISED A TIMELY, REASONABLE AND GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO ABATE A PUBLIC NUISANCE FROM LIABILITY FOR SUCH NUISANCE UNDER THIS CHAPTER; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH

Summary: Exempts certain persons from liability for public nuisance activity if they have made reasonable efforts to abate the nuisance.

The above and foregoing ordinance was first proposed and read by title to the City Council on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1998 and referred to the following committee composed of Councilmen McDonald and Brown for recommendation; thereafter the said committee reported favorably on said ordinance on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1998, which was a regular meeting of said City Council; and that at said regular meeting the proposed ordinance was read by title to the City Council as first introduced and adopted by the following vote:
