AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GRANTING A FRANCHISE; GRANTING TO COX COMMUNICATIONS OF LAS VEGAS, INC., A DELAWARE CORPORATION, AUTHORIZED TO DO BUSINESS IN NEVADA, A NON-EXCLUSIVE FRANCHISE FOR A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, SUBJECT TO AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THAT CERTAIN CABLE TELEVISION AGREEMENT ENTERED INTO BETWEEN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS AND COX COMMUNICATIONS OF LAS VEGAS, INC., A DELAWARE CORPORATION; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Grants to Cox Communications of Las Vegas, Inc., a non-exclusive franchise for the purpose of constructing, using and maintaining a cable television system within the corporate limits of the City of Las Vegas, subject to and in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Cable Television Agreement between the City of Las Vegas and Cox Communications of Las Vegas, Inc., incorporated by reference into the proposed ordinance.

The above and foregoing ordinance was first proposed and read by title to the City Council on the 14th day of September, 1998 and referred to the following committee composed of Councilmen McDonald and Brown for recommendation; thereafter the said committee reported favorably on said ordinance on the 28th day of September, 1998, which was a regular meeting of said City Council; and that at said regular meeting the proposed ordinance was read by title to the City Council as first introduced and adopted by the following vote:
