**ORDINANCE NO.**

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING; AMENDING SECTION 19A.04.050(B) OF THE ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, AS ADOPTED BY AND INCORPORATED IN TITLE 19A OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO ELIMINATE THE ABILITY TO OBTAIN A WAIVER OF THE MINIMUM 400- FOOT DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO A LIQUOR ESTABLISHMENT (OFF-PREMISE CONSUMPTION); PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
