ORDINANCE NO. 5155

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO ZONING; AMENDING THE LAND USE TABLES ADOPTED IN SUBCHAPTER 19A.04.010 OF THE ZONING CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, ADOPTED AS AND INCORPORATED IN TITLE 19A OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, TO SET FORTH THE ZONING DISTRICTS IN WHICH CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT-RELATED USES ARE PERMITTED EITHER AS A MATTER OF RIGHT OR BY MEANS OF SPECIAL USE PERMIT; AMENDING SECTION 19A.04.050(B) OF THE ZONING CODE TO ESTABLISH MINIMUM STANDARDS UNDER WHICH A DAILY LABOR SERVICE MAY BE ALLOWED BY MEANS OF SPECIAL USE PERMIT; AMENDING SUBCHAPTER 19A.20.020 OF THE ZONING CODE TO PROVIDE DEFINITIONS OF THE TERMS "EMPLOYMENT AGENCY" AND "DAILY LABOR SERVICE"; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

Summary: Amends the Zoning Code to set forth the zoning districts in which certain employment-related uses are permitted either as a matter of right or by means of special use permit.

McDonald and Brown for recommendation; thereafter the said committee reported favorably on said ordinance on the 12th day of July, 1999, which was a regular meeting of said City Council; and that at said regular meeting the proposed ordinance was read by title to the City Council as first introduced and adopted by the following vote:
