**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CITY'S PARKING METER REGULATIONS TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF A CASHLESS PAYMENT SYSTEM AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO THE DEPOSIT OF COINS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS**

Summary: : Updates the City's parking meter regulations to authorize the use of a cashless payment system as an alternative to the deposit of coins
