**ORDINANCE NO. 5226**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 6.42 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING THE DELIVERY OF UNSOLICITED MATERIALS TO RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES, AND TO PROVIDE FOR OTHER RELATED MATTERS.**

Summary: Prohibits the continued delivery of unsolicited materials to residential premises after notice to discontinue has been provided
