**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON THE INTENT OF THE LAS VEGAS-CLARK COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT, NEVADA, TO SEEK DEBT MANAGEMENT COMMISSION APPROVAL AND VOTER APPROVAL OF A PROPOSAL TO ISSUE GENERAL OBLIGATIONS AND LEVY A SPECIAL ELECTIVE TAX FOR LIBRARY PURPOSES.**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the City Council (the "Council") of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada (the "City") will hold a public hearing on the intent of the Las Vegas-Clark County Library District, Nevada (the "District") to seek approval of the registered voters of the District (subject to the approval of the Debt Management Commission of Clark County) of the following proposal to issue general obligations and levy a special elective tax for library purposes:

**LIBRARY GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND AND SPECIAL ELECTIVE TAX PROPOSAL:**

Shall the Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Nevada, on behalf of the Board Trustees of the Las Vegas-Clark County Library District be authorized to:

(A) Issue up to \$73,905,000 of general obligation bonds in one or more series for library purposes (including, without limitation, acquiring, constructing, equipping and improving library facilities)? Each series of Bonds are expected to require a property tax levy for 20 years. The Bonds are estimated to result in an increase in the property taxes that the owner of a new \$100,000 home will pay which will average \$4.06 per year; and

(B) Levy an additional property tax rate for library purposes (including, without limitation, operating, maintaining, acquiring, constructing, equipping and improving library facilities) of up to 3 cents per \$100 assessed valuation for a period of 30 years commencing July 1, 2001? The cost of the 3 cent property tax levy for the owner of a new \$100,000 home is estimated to be \$10.50 per year.

All persons interested are hereby advised that the Council will hold the public hearing on Wednesday, February 7, 2001 at 9:30 a.m., in the Council Chambers, Las Vegas City Hall Complex, 400 Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada. All persons are invited to attend and to be heard.
