Pursuant to Section 302 of the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings adopted as Section 16.08.010 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ON **Wednesday, March 20, 2002**, at the hour of **1:00 P.M.**, in the Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, 400 Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, the City Council will consider the following REPORTS OF EXPENSES submitted by the Director of Neighborhood Services incurred by the City of Las Vegas for:

Abatement of the property by demolishing the structure; cleaning and removing all trash and debris; fencing in the pool; and posting "No Trespassing/Dumping" signs on property located at **4308 VEGAS DRIVE** legally described as **PT SE4 SW4 SEC 19 20 61**. Owner of record at time of abatement: **ROBERT G. WIDEMAN & SOPHIE WOODS – WARD 5 (WEEKLY)**

The Director of Neighborhood Services certifies in the report that the sum of \$5,451.00 was expended (\$4,740.00 to Weaver Construction for securing and cleaning the property, and \$711.00 Administrative Processing Fee).

Abatement of the property by securing and boarding the vacant buildings; cleaning and removing all trash and debris; and posting "No Trespassing" signs on property located at **323 NORTH 11TH STREET** legally described as **FAIRVIEW TRACT, PLAT BOOK 1, PAGE 7, LOT 11, BLOCK 10**. Owner of record at time of abatement: **VICTOR & NANCY JARA– WARD 5 (WEEKLY)**

The Director of Neighborhood Services certifies in the report that the sum of \$2,196.40 was expended (\$1,736.00 to K. O. Construction for securing and cleaning the property, \$200 Boarding Fee and \$260.40 Administrative Processing Fee).

If upon hearing the report, the City Council is satisfied with the correctness of the expenses incurred by the City, it may order a lien of assessment recorded and given to the County Treasurer to be collected in the same manner as ordinary property taxes.

Any person interested in or affected by the proposed charge may file written protests or objections with the City Clerk at any time prior to the time set for the hearing on the Report of Expenses. Each such protest or objection must contain a description of the property in which the signer thereof is interested and the grounds of such protest or objection. The City Clerk shall endorse on every such protest or objection the date it was received by her. She shall present such protests or objections to the City Council at the time set for the hearing, and no other protests or objections shall be considered.
