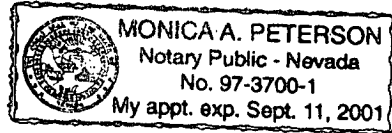

**RESOLUTION R-90-98**

**REGARDING THE GRANTING OF A CABLE TELEVISION SYSTEM  
FRANCHISE TO COX COMMUNICATIONS OF LAS VEGAS, INC., SETTING  
THE PURPOSE, CHARACTER, TERM, TIME AND CONDITIONS OF THE  
PROPOSED FRANCHISE AND SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE  
ADVISABILITY OF GRANTING THE PROPOSED FRANCHISE**

WHEREAS, CITY OF LAS VEGAS (CITY), is desirous of providing its residents the opportunity to receive cable television service; and

WHEREAS, COX COMMUNICATIONS OF LAS VEGAS, INC. (CCLV), A SUBSIDIARY OF COX COMMUNICATIONS, INC. (CCI) is a Delaware corporation authorized to do business in the State of Nevada, created for the purpose of providing a cable television system; and

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of August, 1998, CCLV, a corporation organized and licensed to do business under the laws of the State of Nevada, applied, by letter, to the CITY, for a franchise permitting the installation, maintenance and use of a cable television system within the corporate limits of the CITY; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to insure that the installation, maintenance and use of a cable television system within the corporate limits of the CITY is conducted in a manner which will not interfere with the public's use of improved or unimproved public roads, highways, freeways, streets, avenues, lanes, paths, alleys, drives, parkways, courts and easements now or hereafter existing; and

WHEREAS, in response to CCLV's request for franchise a proposed Cable Television Agreement between the CITY and CCLV has been prepared granting the necessary permission and authority to CCLV to utilize the various improved or unimproved public roads, highways, freeways, streets, avenues, lanes, paths, alleys, drives, parkways, courts and easements, now or hereafter existing, for purposes of installing, maintaining and using its cable television system.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the requirements of Section 7.050 of the Las Vegas Charter, IT IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED, DETERMINED AND RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, as follows:

1. That CCLV did, on the 18th day of August, 1998, file an application, by letter, with the CITY requesting that a franchise be granted to CCLV for the purpose of installing, maintaining and using a cable television system within the corporate boundaries of the CITY;

2. That the purpose, character, terms, time and conditions of the franchise that the CITY proposes to grant to CCLV for a cable television system, for a ten (10) year term, with a five (5) year extension under the same terms and conditions upon request of CCLV, with a second five (5) year extension conditioned upon specific criteria being met by CCLV, is fully set forth in the proposed Cable Television Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, which said proposed Cable Television Agreement is available for inspection by members of the public. Said proposed Cable Television Agreement is, by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part of this Resolution and Notice.

3. That a public hearing be, and it hereby is, set for Monday, the 28th day of September, 1998, in the City Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, 400 East Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, at the hour of 10:00 a.m., for the purpose of hearing any objections or protests made by any person to the granting of a cable television system franchise to CCLV pursuant to the proposed Cable Television Agreement;

4. That all interested persons shall have, and they are hereby given, the right to appear and be heard on the question of the advisability of granting a cable television system franchise pursuant to the proposed Cable Television Agreement to CCLV at the place, date and hour specified for the public hearing in paragraph 3 of this Resolution and Notice, or at any subsequent time to which said public hearing may be adjourned.

5. That the notice provided by this Resolution and Notice is reasonably calculated to inform each interested person of his or her opportunity to appear and be heard on the question of the granting of a cable television system franchise pursuant to the proposed Cable Television Agreement; and that the City Clerk therefore, be, and she hereby is, authorized, empowered and directed to cause a copy of this Resolution and Notice to be published in full in the issues of the Las Vegas Review Journal published on the 17th day of September, 1998, and the 23rd day of September, 1998.
