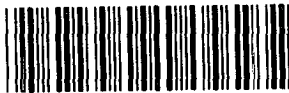

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on
Wednesday, June 15, 1988, at the
hour of 2:00 P.M., in the Council
Chambers, City Hall Complex, 40
East Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas,
Nevada, the City Council will consid-
er a report by the Director of Build-
ing & Safety of the expense incurred
by the City of Las Vegas to clean the
vacant lot behind 1900 Lirio. This
hearing is being scheduled pursuant
to Title 9, Chapter 12 of the Las
Vegas Municipal Code, Litter Abate-
ment.
The above property is legally de-
scribed as:
LOT 2, SF#36-80, PT NW4, SE-
SEC23-20-60
The Director of Building & Safety
certifies in the report that the sum of
\$3,116.50 was expended to Weaver
Construction Company for the clear-
ing of the vacant lot behind 1900
Lirio. If upon hearing the report, the
City Council is satisfied with the
correctness of the expenses in-
curred by the City, it may order
lien of assessment recorded and
given to the County Treasurer to be
collected in the same manner as
ordinary property taxes.
Any person interested in or affected
by the proposed charge may file

written protests or objections with
the City Clerk at any time prior to the
time set for the hearing on the report
of the Director of Building & Safety.
Each such protest or objection must
contain a description of the property
in which the signer thereof is inter-
ested and the grounds of such pro-
test or objection. The City Clerk shall
endorse on every such protest or
objection the date it was received by
her. She shall present such protests
or objections to the City Council at
the time set for the hearing, and no
other protests or objections shall be
considered.
