NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT on Wednesday, June 21, 1989, at the hour of 2:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers, City Hall Complex, 400 East Stewart Avenue, Las Vegas, Nevada, the City Council will consider a report by the Director of Building & Safety of the expense incurred by the City of Las Vegas to abate the dangerous building by demolition and clean the premises and a Property Report on property located at 620 N. 9TH STREET. This hearing is being scheduled pursuant to Section 902 of the Uniform Code for the Abatement of Dangerous Buildings, adopted as Section 16.08.010 of the Las Vegas Municipal Code. The above property is legally described as: STEWART ADDITION, LOT 6, BLOCK 2.
The Director of Building & Safety certifies in the report that the sum of \$1,839.75 was expended (\$1,739.75 to Weaver Construction for the abatement of the dangerous building by demolition and the cleaning of the premises and \$100.00 to Las Vegas Title & Escrow for a Property Report) on property located at 620 N. 9th Street. If upon hearing the report, the City Council is satisfied with the correctness of the expenses incurred by the City, it may order a line of assessment recorded and given to the County Treasurer to be collected in the same manner as ordinary property taxes.
Any person interested in or affected by the proposed charge may file written protests or objections with the City Clerk at any time prior to the time set for the hearing on the report of the Director of Building & Safety. Each such protest or objection must contain a description of the property in which the signer thereof is interested and the grounds of such protests or objection. The City Clerk shall endorse on every such protest or objection the date it was received by her. She shall present such protests or objections to the City Council at the time set for the hearing, and no other protests or objections shall be considered.
