Department of Planning staff has administratively approved your request for technical review of the subject final map, subject to the following comments and conditions:

1. The Original Final Map mylar shall be in conformance with all applicable conditions of approval for Site Development Plan Review (SDR-52994) and the approved Tentative Map of Sahara at Las Vegas Blvd (TMP-50088), which includes references to previously approved active entitlements.
2. The Final Map shall be revised as required by the Department of Planning prior to the submittal of the original Mylar for signature by the city.
3. The file number "FMP-53654" shall be placed above the Recorder's block in the lower right hand corner of the cover sheet.
4. The map title shall be changed to read, "Final Map of Sahara at Las Vegas Blvd" to match the title of the approved Tentative Map. This title shall be used throughout Sheets 1-3.

COMMENTS:

We note that an approved Drainage Plan and Technical Drainage Study update is on file with the Flood Control Section of the Department of Public Works.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. On sheet 1, revise the Owner's Certificate to conform with UDC appendix E.
2. Prior to the recordation of this map, provide all recorders information for dedications and easements (pedestrian and access) being granted by separate document where indicated on sheet 3.
3. Per condition #6 of TMP-50088, curve C5 should be a 54-foot radius. Make the appropriate changes to this Final Map prior to recordation.
4. Per condition #7 of TMP-50088, add one of the following notes to the first sheet:
 - A. The on-site sewer system is a common element of the commercial subdivision which is privately owned and which is maintained in accordance with the covenants, conditions and restrictions that govern the subdivision.
 - B. The on-site sewer system is a common element of the commercial subdivision which is privately owned and which is maintained in accordance with a joint use agreement applicable to the subdivision.
5. Dimensions and information presented on the approved civil improvement plans shall match the Final Map prior to recordation. Revise approved civil plans if necessary.
6. Site development to comply with Site Development Plan Review SDR-34306, Tentative Map TMP-50088 and all other applicable site-related actions.
