Department of Planning staff has administratively approved your request for technical review of the subject final map, subject to the following:

1. The Original Final Map mylar shall be in conformance with all applicable conditions of approval for the approved Tentative Map of Summerlin Village 23B Parcel W (TMP-50086).
2. The Final Map shall be revised as required by the Department of Planning prior to the submittal of the original Mylar for signature by the city.
3. The file number "FMP-56021" shall be placed above the Recorder's block in the lower right hand corner of the cover sheet.
4. The street name "Via Ria" was denied by the Las Vegas Fire and Rescue Department, Communications Division. Use "Toselli Court" instead. If you have any questions regarding this issue, please contact Linda Goodrie at 702-229-0235.
5. Correct the signature block for the Director of Planning to read as follows:

COMMENTS:

We note that this map is showing an area where an easement is being granted by a separate document before this map records and the Final Map mylar will need to clearly document all separate easement(s). We have conditions below that address most of the deficiencies, but it is the Surveyor's responsibility that all pertinent easements are shown correctly on the Final Map mylar. We also note that an approved Drainage Plan and Technical Drainage Study is on file with the Flood Control Section of the Department of Public Works.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL:

1. The Las Vegas Valley Water District Easement being granted in Common Element "F" does not align with the existing Las Vegas Valley Water District Easement shown across Common Lot 8 granted by 20130812:02176. Correct the alignment as necessary or coordinate with the Las Vegas Valley Water District to grant an additional easement by separate document prior to the recordation of this Final Map.
2. Per Condition #9 of TMP-50086, appropriate public easements over the adjacent Common Lots 8 and 16 of Summerlin Village 23B Unit No. 1 (Book 145 page 28) shall be granted to the City of Las Vegas by separate document prior to the recordation of the Final Map for this site. As submitted, it appears that an Emergency Access Easement is needed over adjacent Common Lots 8 to align with the Emergency Access Easement being granted by Common Element "F". All recorded document information shall be placed on the map prior to recordation.
3. Per Condition #14 of TMP-50086, prior to the release of this Final Map, the property owner must contact the Special Improvement District Section of the Department of Public Works (229-2136) and sign a notarized affidavit acknowledging and agreeing to a per lot assessment of all lots being created by this Final Map. The City shall prepare an apportionment report following recordation of the Final Map and this apportionment report must be signed by the property owner prior to the release of any building permits for this site.
4. Dimensions and information presented on the approved civil improvement plans shall match the Final Map prior to recordation. Revise approved civil plans if necessary.
5. Site development to comply with all previous conditions of approval for the Summerlin Village 23B Parcel W (TMP-50086) and also with the Summerlin Development and Improvement Standards.

During the processing and review period of this map the City of Las Vegas has permanently filled the position for City Engineer, therefore, please update the name of the City Engineer.

We note that approximately 14 lots have changed in their geometry in addressing what we had originally believed were some curve labeling issues around a cul-de-sac.

In the future, when map revisions impact a number of lots in this magnitude, a mark-up and or



courtesy call would be much appreciated.

Please label the private street network as a common element lot.

Original comments from the Survey Section instructed you to label the private street as a City of Las Vegas sewer easement. This was incorrect and the street should be more correctly labeled as originally labeled, private street, public sewer easement, public drainage easement and public utility easement to be privately maintained. We apologize for the confusion.

The Las Vegas Valley Water District easement impacting Common Lot F and Residential Lot34 must be relinquished prior to the recordation of this map. For reference the recording information for the easement to be relinquished is Doc:20140128:01024.

Please ensure that all recording information is complete prior to returning the Mylar for final approval.

Please correct miscellaneous errors, typos, or omissions as shown on the redlines.

Please note this is a second memo and these comments supersede previous comments from the Survey Section only.
