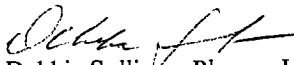
It has been determined that the removal of three (3) existing antennas; installation of three (3) new eight-foot panel antennas (one per sector), and six (6) Radio Remote Heads (two per sector) at the 75'-6" centerline of an existing 85-foot tall Wireless Communication Facility, Stealth Design (Monopalm); in addition to installing one (1) GPS antenna near the base of the facility located at 1455 North Jones Boulevard meets the standard for approval as defined in Title 19.12.010 and 19.18.020 of the Unified Development Code of the city of Las Vegas, subject to the following.

1. Conformance to the submitted site plan and elevations date-stamped April 14, 2011.
2. **The applicant shall replace all existing fronds with new plush/fuller fronds and fill each opening to enhance the concealment of associated equipment.**
3. This approval shall be void one year from the date of final approval, unless a building permit has been issued for the proposed installation. An Extension of Time may be filed for consideration by the City of Las Vegas.
4. Any equipment located on the outside of the shelter and or building shall be painted to match the color of the exterior wall.
5. The wireless communications facility and its associated equipment and screening shall be properly maintained and kept free of graffiti at all times by the monopole owner. Failure to perform the required maintenance may result in fines and/or removal of the facility and its associated equipment. If abandoned, the property owner must obtain a demolition permit to remove the equipment within thirty (30) days of abandonment. All equipment must then be removed within six (6) months after operations at the site cease.

A Special Use Permit application will not be required prior to submittal of building permits. A copy of this letter must be included in the permit package.
