The City Council at a regular meeting held on August 21, 2019 voted to **APPROVE** a City Council Review of the Denial by the Planning Commission on a request for a Special Use Permit FOR A PROPOSED 7,800 SQUARE-FOOT NIGHTCLUB USE WITH 1,000 SQUARE FEET OF OUTDOOR SEATING WITH A WAIVER TO ALLOW A 385-FOOT DISTANCE SEPARATION FROM A CHURCH/HOUSE OF WORSHIP WHERE 1,500 FEET IS REQUIRED at 4545 West Sahara Avenue (APN 162-07-101-020), C-1 (Limited Commercial) Zone, Ward 1 (Knudsen) [PRJ-76404].

This approval is subject to the following conditions:

Planning

1. Conformance to all Minimum Requirements under LVMC Title 19.12 for a Nightclub in conjunction with an establishment that has a tavern-restricted license.
2. Approval of and conformance to the Conditions of Approval for Variance (VAR-76469) and Special Use Permit (SUP-76470) shall be required.
3. Conformance to the approved conditions for Site Development Plan Review (SDR-65925).
4. This approval shall be void two years from the date of final approval, unless exercised pursuant to the provisions of LVMC Title 19.16. An Extension of Time may be filed for consideration by the City of Las Vegas.

5. This Special Use Permit requires operation in conjunction with an establishment that has a tavern-restricted alcoholic beverage license pursuant to LVMC 6.50.253.
6. All necessary building permits shall be obtained and final inspections shall be completed in compliance with Title 19 and all codes as required by the Department of Building and Safety.
7. These Conditions of Approval shall be affixed to the cover sheet of any plan set submitted for building permit, as well as submitted as part of any business license application.
8. Approval of this Special Use Permit does not constitute approval of a liquor license.
9. This business shall operate in conformance to Chapter 6.50 of the City of Las Vegas Municipal Code.
10. All City Code requirements and design standards of all City departments must be satisfied, except as modified herein.
