THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Title 3, Chapter 12, Section 10, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1983 Edition, of the is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.12.010: Every person now in the employ of the City, and every person who makes application for appointment or employment shall, as a condition of such appointment or employment, take the following oath:


I, _____, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I will support, protect and defend the [constitution and government] Constitution and Government of the United States[,] and the constitution and government of the State of Nevada[,] against all enemies, whether domestic or foreign, [and] that I will bear true faith, allegiance, and loyalty to the same, any ordinance, resolution, or law of any state convention or legislature to the contrary notwithstanding[. And I further solemnly swear (or affirm) that I do not believe in, advocate or advise the use of force or violence, or other unlawful or unconstitutional means to overthrow or make any change in the Government established in the United States, the State of Nevada, or the City of Las Vegas; that I am not a member of or affiliated with any organization, association, party group or combination of persons which approves, advocates, advi-


1 ses, or practices the use of force, or violence, or other
2 unlawful or unconstitutional means, to overthrow or make any
3 change in any of the Governments so established; and that I
4 am not bound by any allegiance to any foreign prince, poten-
5 tate, state or sovereignty whatever; So] and that I will well
6 and faithfully perform all of the duties of the position in
7 which I am about to enter, (if an oath) so help me God[.] or
8 (if an affirmation) under the pains and penalties of perjury.


9 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
10 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this ordinance or any
11 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
12 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
13 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
14 the remaining portions of this ordinance or any part thereof.
15 The City Council of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby
16 declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, sub-
17 division, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespec-
18 tive of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, sub-
19 divisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
20 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

21 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
22 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
23 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
24 1983 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

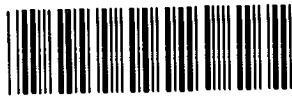
