 AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, MORALS AND WELFARE; AMENDING TITLE 2 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1983 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW CHAPTER, DESIGNATED AS CHAPTER 27 AND ENTITLED "JUDICIAL POLICY COMMITTEE ON SENTENCING ALTERNATIVES," ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE TO DEVELOP, INSTITUTE AND REVIEW POLICIES AND PROCEDURES FOR EFFECTIVE USE OF SENTENCING ALTERNATIVE AVAILABLE FOR USE BY JUDGES OF MUNICIPAL COURTS; PROVIDING FOR THE COMPOSITION OF SAID COMMITTEE; ESTABLISHING THE SALARIES FOR THE MEMBERS THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HERewith.
