6 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION TO RESOLVE CON-
7 FFLICTS BETWEEN THE SECTIONS IN DEFINING LEGAL HOLIDAYS; TO PRO-
8 VIDE FOR OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND TO REPEAL
9 ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.

11 Summary: To amend the definition of
12 legal holidays as found in the park-
13 ing meter ordinance and city employee
14 ordinance for holiday vacations to
15 resolve conflicts between the sec-
16 tions.

17 THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS
18 VEGAS, NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

19 SECTION 1: Title X, Chapter 3, Section 6, Subsection
20 (A) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960
21 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

22 10-3-6: PARKING TIME LIMITS

23 (A) Parking meters shall be operated in the parking
24 meter zone every day between the hours of nine
25 o'clock (9:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) P.M.,
26 except Sundays and legal holidays, and except
27 as hereinafter in subsection (B) 2 expressly pro-
28 vided. Within the meaning of this Chapter, the
29 term "holiday" shall include the following days
30 only: January 1, the third Monday in February,
31 the [fourth] last Monday in May, July 4, the first
32 Monday in September, [the second Monday in October,
the fourth Monday in October], October 31,
November 11, [Thanksgiving Day], the fourth Thurs-
day in November, December 25, and any declared
general holiday by the President of the United
States, Governor of the State of Nevada, or Mayor
of the City of Las Vegas except for any Presidential

1 appointment of the fourth Monday in October as
2 Veteran's Day; provided, however, that by resolu-
3 tion of the majority of its members, the Board of
4 Commissioners may extend the time for operation of
5 any parking meters in the parking meter zone for
6 an additional period of time; provided, the proper
7 notice for such extended time of operation is
8 placed on each such parking meter.

9 SECTION 2: Title I, Chapter 6, Section 2 of the Munici-
10 pal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby
11 amended to read as follows:

12 1-6-2: HOLIDAYS: Every employee of the City, in addition to
13 earned vacation, shall be entitled to vacation on the
14 following holidays during the year:

15 January 1 (New Year's Day)

16 [February 22] Third Monday in February (Washington's
17 Birthday)

18 [May 30] Last Monday in May (Memorial Day)

19 July 4 (Independence Day)

20 First Monday in September (Labor Day)

21 October 31 (Nevada Day)

22 November 11 (Veteran's Day)

23 [Thanksgiving Day] Fourth Thursday in November
24 (Thanksgiving Day)

25 December 25 (Christmas)

26 Any day that may be declared a Holiday by the
27 President of the United States, Governor of the
28 State of Nevada, or the Mayor of the City of Las
29 Vegas, except for any Presidential appointment of
30 the Fourth Monday in October as Veteran's Day.

31 If any of the above holidays fall on Sunday, the follow-
32 ing Monday shall be considered as the legal holiday. If

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any of the above holidays fall on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be considered as the legal holiday.

All full time employees in the service of the City shall be entitled to time off for legal holidays when such holidays fall on regularly scheduled work days, as provided in the Civil Service Rules of the City.

SECTION 3: If any section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

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
