8 QUIREMENT THAT EACH ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNER BE NOTIFIED BY
9 REGISTERED MAIL OF A PROPOSED STREET NAME CHANGE AND REQUIRING
10 NOTIFICATION BY REGULAR MAIL INSTEAD; TO PROVIDE OTHER MATTERS
11 PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND TO REPEAL ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS
12 OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

14 THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
15 NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

16 SECTION 1: Title XI, Chapter 1, Section 25.6 of the
17 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is
18 hereby amended as follows:

19 11-1-25.6: STREET NAME CHANGES:

- 20 (A) Any abutting property owner or local government desiring to
21 change the name of any street, or portion thereof, in the
22 City of Las Vegas shall file two (2) copies of a petition in
23 writing with the Secretary of the Planning Commission. The
24 petition shall describe with certainty the portion of the
25 street or streets to be affected and be signed by the abutting
26 property owner or representative of the local government
27 initiating the petition.
- 28 (B) Any petition initiated by an abutting property owner shall be
29 accompanied by a filing fee of two hundred dollars (\$200.00)
30 to partially defray the costs of making maps, mailing and
31 publishing notices and other administrative and investigative
32 expenses. In addition, when a petition is filed by an abutting

1 property owner which involves a street, or portion thereof,
2 that affects fifty (50) or more abutting property owners,
3 the applicant shall pay all notification costs. Payment of
4 the notification costs shall accompany the application as
5 required by the Department of Community Planning and
6 Development.

7 (C) The petition shall be submitted to the Planning Commission
8 which shall report thereon to the Board of City Commissioners
9 within forty (40) days after receipt of the petition. The
10 Secretary of the Planning Commission shall endeavor to mail
11 notices of the Planning Commission meeting at which the
12 petition will be considered to all persons owning property
13 abutting the street or streets to be affected by the proposed
14 name change; however, the failure to do so shall not invali-
15 date any action taken at the meeting.

16 (D) The Planning Commission's recommendation shall be referred to
17 the City Commission for action. The City Commission shall
18 [notify by registered mail] mail a notice to each owner of
19 property abutting the portion of the street to be affected
20 and cause a notice to be published at least once in a news-
21 paper of general circulation in the City, setting forth the
22 extent of the proposed name change and setting a date for
23 public hearing, which date may not be less than ten (10) days
24 and not more than forty (40) days subsequent to the date of
25 the notification. Any persons desiring to object to the
26 proposed name change may appear at the meeting and shall be
27 heard.

28 (E) If, upon public hearing, the City Commission finds that it is
29 in the best interest of the public and that no person will be
30 materially injured thereby, it may order that the name of
31 the street be changed.

32 (F) The order shall be recorded by the City Commission in the


1 office of the County Recorder and in the event the original
2 name of the affected street is indicated on a subdivision
3 map, parcel map or plat on file with the Recorder, the
4 County Recorder shall make a written notation of the name
5 change on any map affected by the order.

6 SECTION 2: If any section, subsection, subdivision,
7 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any
8 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, or
9 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
10 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
11 the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
12 Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas hereby declares
13 that it would have passed each section, subsection, subdivision,
14 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof irrespective of
15 the fact that any one or more sections, subsections, subdivisions,
16 paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared unconstitu-
17 tional, invalid or ineffective.


18 SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
19 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
20 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
21 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

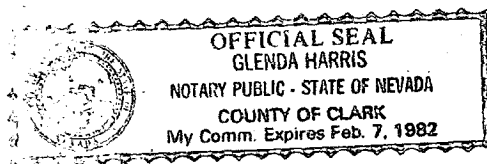
