18 THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS,
19 NEVADA, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

20 SECTION 1: Title V, Chapter 17, Section 7 of the
21 Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition
22 is hereby amended as follows:

23 5-17-7: All applications for licenses [or renewals thereof]
24 shall be made [by petition] to the Board of Com-
25 missioners by filing the same with the Director of
26 [Licenses] the Department of Business Activities.
27 [who shall immediately refer each such application
28 to the Board at or before the next meeting thereof
29 after receipt of such petition by him.] The application
30 may be submitted upon copies of forms previously filed
31 by the applicant with the State Gaming Control Board
32 but the Director of Business Activities may require
supplemental or updated information and statements
with the application. [The same may be acted upon by
the Board at any regular or recessed regular meeting
of such Board.] A majority vote of the members pre-
sent shall be necessary to authorize the issuance
[or renewal] of any license. [at any such meeting.]

1 SECTION 2. If any section, subsection, subdivision,
2 paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase in this Chapter or any
3 part thereof, is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or
4 invalid or ineffective by any court of competent jurisdiction,
5 such decision shall not affect the validity or effectiveness of
6 the remaining portions of this Chapter or any part thereof. The
7 Board of City Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
8 hereby declares that it would have passed each section, subsection,
9 subdivision, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, ir-
10 respective of the fact that any one or more sections, subsections,
11 subdivisions, paragraphs, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
12 unconstitutional, invalid or ineffective.

13 SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances,
14 sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs
15 contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada,
16 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

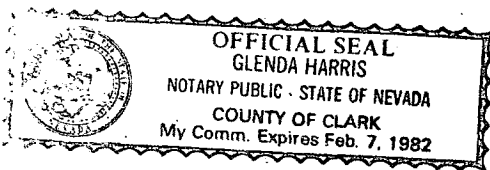
