

ORDINANCE NO. 1474

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IX, CHAPTER 15 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADOPTING SECTION 4, SUBSECTIONS A AND B TO PROVIDE FOR STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR CONTRACTS AWARDED FOR TRAFFIC SIGNALS AND COPIES OF SPECIFICATIONS TO BE PROVIDED THEREFOR; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IX, Chapter 15 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section, designated Section 4 to read as follows:

9-15-4 Standards Adopted: A certain document, three (3) copies of which are on file in the Office of the Clerk, being marked and designated as "Traffic Signal Standard Drawings, Department of Public Works, Las Vegas, Nevada, May, 1970" is by such reference and adoption made a part of this Chapter the same as if it were fully set forth herein.

(A) The provisions of the "Traffic Signal Standard Drawings, Department of Public Works, Las Vegas, Nevada, May, 1970," shall govern operation of contracts for traffic signals awarded by the City of Las Vegas unless the content of any individual contract, together with any changes in the plans and specifications therefor shall govern and be binding upon the City and the contractor. These provisions will apply to public improvements under installation through permits approved by the Director of Public Works,

(B) The Department of Public Works shall furnish a copy of such document upon request and without charge to a person or persons desiring a copy.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine or imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

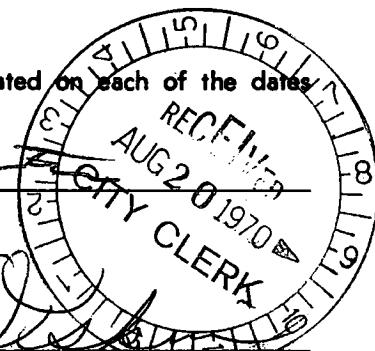
