

ORDINANCE NO. 1468

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE IX, CHAPTER 8, SECTION 12, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING SUBSECTIONS (F) AND (G) TO PROVIDE FOR THE MANNER AND METHOD OF INVESTING CEMETERY PERPETUAL CARE FUNDS IN CONFORMANCE WITH NRS 452.190; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title IX, Chapter 8, Section 12, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-8-12 PERPETUAL CARE FUNDS: Perpetual care funds received under contract for the perpetual care of lots in the municipal cemetery shall be invested in the manner and method as follows:

- (a) Bonds of the United States; or
- (b) Bonds of this state; or
- (c) Bonds of other states of the Union; or
- (d) Bonds of counties or other municipalities of the states of the Union; or
- (e) Bank deposits in any bank or savings and loan association which is insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; or
- (f) With the approval of the state board of finance, first mortgages or first trust deeds on improved real estate; or
- (g) With the approval of the state board of finance, any investment which would be proper under the provisions of NRS 164.050.


Pending investment as provided in this section, such funds may be deposited in any savings bank in this state.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1, Title IX, Chapter 8, Section 12, of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-8-12 PERPETUAL CARE FUNDS: Perpetual care funds received under contract for the perpetual care of lots in the municipal cemetery shall be invested in the manner and method as follows:

- (a) Bonds of the United States; or
- (b) Bonds of this state; or
- (c) Bonds of other states of the Union; or

- (e) Bank deposits in any bank for savings and loan association which is insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation; or
- (f) With the approval of the state board of finance, first mortgages or first trust deeds on improved real estate; or
- (g) With the approval of the state board of finance, any investment which would be proper under the provisions of NRS 164.050.

Pending investment as provided in this section, such funds may be deposited in any savings bank in this state.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
