

ORDINANCE NO. 1454

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE II, CHAPTER 5, SECTION 12, SUBSECTION I, BY ADDING THERETO A SENTENCE TO EXEMPT FAMILY CARE HOME PROVIDING CARE FOR THREE OR LESS CHILDREN; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title II, Chapter 5, Section 12, Subsection I of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-5-12 (I) Combustible Decorations: All drapes, hangings, curtains, drops and all similar decorations that tend to increase the fire and panic hazards shall be made from a nonflammable material, or shall be treated and maintained in a flame retardant condition by means of a flame retardant solution or process approved by the Fire Prevention Bureau of the City. This provision shall not apply to a family care home providing care for three (3) or less children on a daytime basis only.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.



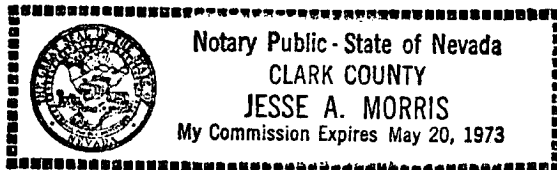

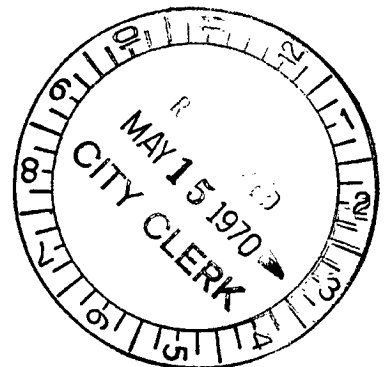
