

ORDINANCE NO. 1453

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 1410 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, RE-ADOPTING AS PART 1 THEREOF THE 1967 UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE AND ADOPTING AS PART 2 THEREOF A SUPPLEMENTAL DOCUMENT PROVIDING AMENDMENTS, CHANGES AND DELETIONS TO THE UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE, 1967 EDITION, ALL HAVING BEEN ADOPTED THEREIN BY REFERENCE, BY AMENDING SECTION 6 OF SAID PART 2 BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SUBSECTION DESIGNATED AS SUBSECTION (f) PROVIDING THAT PERMITS WILL BE ISSUED TO ANY GENERAL ENGINEERING CONTRACTOR, OR TO ANY SEWER, SEWAGE DISPOSAL, DRAIN AND PIPELAYING CONTRACTOR, PIPELINE CONTRACTOR OR INDUSTRIAL PIPING CONTRACTOR WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE SPECIALITIES, LICENSED BY THE STATE OF NEVADA, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF SEWER, WATER, OR OTHER UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY UP TO A POINT NOT LESS THAN FIVE FEET FROM THE NEAREST BUILDING LINE; BY FURTHER AMENDING SAID PART 2 TO PROVIDE A NEW DEFINITION OF "PLUMBING SYSTEM" SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 1 OF SAID UNIFORM PLUMBING CODE TO ALLOW SEWER, WATER OR OTHER UNDERGROUND UTILITY LINES TO BE CONSTRUCTED AND INSTALLED BY ANY GENERAL ENGINEERING CONTRACTOR, OR TO ANY SEWER, SEWAGE DISPOSAL, DRAIN AND PIPELAYING CONTRACTOR, PIPELINE CONTRACTOR OR INDUSTRIAL PIPING CONTRACTOR WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE SPECIALITIES, LICENSED BY THE STATE OF NEVADA ON PRIVATE OR PUBLIC PROPERTY UP TO A POINT NOT LESS THAN FIVE FEET FROM THE NEAREST BUILDING LINE; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 1410 of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada is hereby amended by amending Section 6 of the supplemental document adopted by reference as Part 2 of the Plumbing Code of the City of Las Vegas by adding thereto a new subsection, to be designated Subsection (f), to read as follows:

- (f) A permit may be issued to any General Engineering Contractor, or to any sewer, sewage disposal, drain and pipelaying contractor, pipeline contractor or industrial piping contractor within their respective specialties, licensed by the State of Nevada, for the construction and installation of sewer, water or other underground utility lines on private or public property up to a point not less than five (5) feet from the nearest building line.

SECTION 2: Said Ordinance No. 1410 is hereby further amended by adding to said supplemental document a new section, to be designated 18A, amending the definition of "plumbing system" as contained in Chapter 1 of the Uniform Plumbing Code, 1967 Edition, to read as follows:

Plumbing system - The plumbing system means and includes all potable water supply and distribution pipes, all plumbing fixtures and traps, all drainage and vent pipe and all building drains, including their respective joints and connections, devices, receptacles and appurtenances within the property lines of the premises and shall include potable water piping, potable water treating or using equipment, fuel gas piping, water heaters and vents for same; provided, however, that nothing in this Code shall be construed to prohibit the construction and installation by any General Engineering Contractor, or to any sewer, sewage disposal, drain and pipe-laying contractor, pipeline contractor or industrial piping contractor within their respective specialities, licensed by the State of Nevada, of sewer, water or other underground lines on private or public property up to a point not less than five (5) feet from the nearest building line.

SECTION 3: Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4: All ordinances or parts of ordinance, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

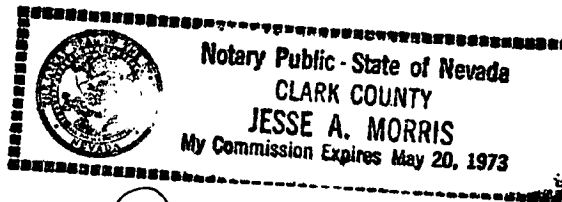

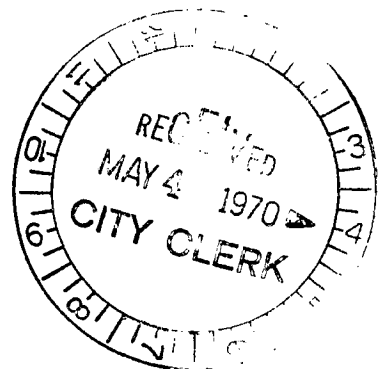
