

ORDINANCE NO. 1451

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VII, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION (M) OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING THERETO TWO NEW PARAGRAPHS DESIGNATED PARAGRAPHS (M-a) AND (M-b), AND TO AMEND ARTICLE 27, SECTION 27.1, SUBSECTION a, OF THE "FIRE PREVENTION CODE, 1965 EDITION," ADOPTED BY REFERENCE AS THE "FIRE PREVENTION CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA" TO FURTHER DEFINE DECORATIVE MATERIALS PERMITTED IN PLACES OF ASSEMBLY; TO AMEND TITLE VII, CHAPTER 3, SECTION 3, SUBSECTION (P) OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE AND TO AMEND ARTICLE 28, SECTION 28.9 OF SAID FIRE PREVENTION CODE TO PROVIDE THAT INTERIOR FINISH OF ROOMS IN BUILDINGS OF MERCANTILE AND INSTITUTIONAL OCCUPANCY OF MORE THAN FOUR PERSONS SHALL BE OF CLASS A MATERIALS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VII, Chapter 3, Section 3, Subsection (M) of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto two new paragraphs, designated paragraphs (M-a) and (M-b), to read as follows:

7-3-3: (M-a) ARTICLE 21, LIQUEFIED PETEROLEUM GASES, is hereby repealed in its entirety and a pamphlet known as A.I.A. Bulletin No. 58 entitled "STORAGE AND HANDLING OF LIQUID PETROLEUM GASES" is hereby adopted under separate ordinance to be known as the "Liquefied Petroleum Gas Code."

ARTICLE 27. PLACES OF ASSEMBLY, Section 27.1., Definitions, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(M-b) a. Decorative material shall include all such materials as curtains, draperies, streamers, surface coverings applied over the building interior finish for decorative, acoustical or other effect, and also cloth, cotton batting, straw, vines, leaves, trees and moss used for decorative effect, and shall include floor coverings and ordinary window shades, but shall not include materials one-fortieth* of an inch or less in thickness applied directly to and adhering tightly to a noncombustible base.

*May be measured by folding a piece to 5 thicknesses and measuring to see if the thickness of 5 layers exceeds 1/8 inch.

SECTION 2. Title VII, Chapter 3, Section 3, Subsection (P) of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-3-3: (P) Section 28.9, Flammable Decorative Materials in Buildings of Mercantile and Institutional Occupancy, is hereby amended to read as follows:


28.9 a. Highly flammable materials such as cotton batting, straw, dry vines, leaves, trees, artificial flowers or shrubbery and foam plastic materials shall not be used for decorative purposes in show windows or other parts of mercantile and institutional occupancies unless first rendered flameproofed in accordance with Section 27.3. Electric light bulbs in mercantile and institutional occupancies shall not be decorated with paper or other combustible materials unless such materials shall first have been rendered flameproofed.

b. Any interior finish as defined in Section 27.1 in any means or egress shall be Class A. Any interior finish of any room shall be Class A, except that Class B materials may be used in individual rooms of not more than four persons capacity.


SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses, sentences or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
