

ORDINANCE NO. 835

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 778 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE OF 1958, WITH CERTAIN CHANGES, BY PROVIDING A NEW CLASSIFICATION FOR CASINOS AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Part III of the Building Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended by inserting at the end of Section 3 thereof a new section 3.1, reading as follows:

"Section 404 is amended by adding at the end thereof the word "casino" and the following description -
"Casino" - For the purposes of this Code the word "Casino", as used herein, shall mean an existing building occupied by a gaming establishment wherein gambling games, in addition to slot machines, are employed and shall include restaurants, cocktail lounges, bars, offices and/or other uses pertaining to such gaming establishment when all are within the confines of the same building and not separated one from the other by fire resistive occupancy separations."

SECTION 2. Chapter 7, Section 701 of the Uniform Building Code of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended by adding thereto the words "Division 5", defined as follows:

"Division 5. Casinos (as defined in Sec. 404).

Said Chapter 7 is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section designated as Section 710, reading as follows:

"Sec. 710. Group "B" - Division 5 occupancies which operate on a 24 hour a day basis and employ personnel to make regular rounds of the entire premises to check for fire and/or fire hazards need not comply with the area or height limitations set forth in this Code, provided that all construction is Type I, II or III one-hour."

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$500.00, or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding six (6) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final reading and adoption, and final publication as in the next section provided.

SECTION 6. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption, in a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, Nevada.
