

ORDINANCE NO. 827

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL SECTION 8 OF ORDINANCE NO. 667 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF PRIVATE DETECTIVES; DEFINING PRIVATE DETECTIVES; REQUIRING PAYMENT OF A LICENSE FEE; PROVIDING FOR APPLICATIONS FOR PRIVATE DETECTIVE LICENSES; PROVIDING REASONABLE LIMITATION OF THE NUMBER OF LICENSES TO BE ISSUED OR IN EFFECT AT ANY ONE TIME; REQUIRING A BOND; PROVIDING FOR INVESTIGATION OF APPLICANTS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO".

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 8 of Ordinance No. 667 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final reading and adoption, and final publication as in the next section provided.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
