

ORDINANCE NO. 826

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT CERTAIN DISABLED PERSONS TO PARK WITHIN THE CITY IN RESTRICTED PARKING ZONES; PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS THEREOF IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Any person who has lost, or has lost the use of, one leg, or is so severely disabled as to be unable to move without the aid of a wheelchair, or is so severely disabled that he has been restricted on his license to operate a vehicle so that it makes it necessary that his vehicle be equipped with special equipment, shall be allowed to park for unlimited periods in parking zones restricted as to length of time. This ordinance shall not be construed, however, to allow the stopping, parking, or standing of all vehicles is prohibited absolutely by state law or local ordinance, or which are reserved for special types of vehicles, except in loading or taxi zones, where parking will be permitted for ten minutes.

As a condition to this privilege the vehicle shall display a distinguishing emblem or sign denoting the vehicle as being registered to a disabled person within the meaning of this ordinance. Emblems shall be obtained, issued, and registered by the Las Vegas Police Department, upon the condition that such vehicle, when parked as permitted by this section, shall be operated only by such disabled person, or an operator in his behalf.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or six (6) months in jail, or by a combination of both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect as in the next section provided, and final passage.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
