

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 468 ADOPTING THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, BY PERMITTING EMPLOYEES HOLDING CIVIL SERVICE STATUS TO BE GRANTED LEAVE TO ACCEPT AN APPOINTIVE POSITION WITHIN THE CITY AND TO RETAIN CIVIL SERVICE STATUS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Section IX of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations of the City of Las Vegas is hereby amended by adding thereto Paragraph (g) to read as follows:

(g) An employee holding civil service status under these Rules and Regulations may be granted leave by the Civil Service Board from said service to accept an appointive position with the City of Las Vegas. While on leave said employee shall be permitted to take scheduled promotional examinations, and upon completion, or resignation from said appointive position, said employee shall be returned to the Civil Service status held when leave was granted or to the status thereafter acquired by promotional examination.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final reading and adoption, and final publication as in the next section provided.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
