

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 36, SECTION 67, CODE OF LAS VEGAS, 1949, BY PROVIDING FOR ALLEY PARKING WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Section 67, Code of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 67. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN ALLEYS.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time in the alley or portions thereof described in the following schedule:

1. On both sides of the north-south alley located between Fremont Street and Ogden Avenue, and between Main Street and First Street, from a point 30 feet south of the east-west alley in said block, to a point 75 feet north.
2. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden; commencing at the north-south alley located between Main Street and First Street, to a point 30 feet to the east.
3. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden, commencing at the north-south alley located between Main and First Streets east to Fourth Street.
4. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden, commencing at Fourth Street east to Sixth Street.
5. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont Street and Carson Avenue commencing at Fourth Street east to Sixth Street.
6. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at Second Street east to Fourth Street.
7. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at Second Street to the north-south alley located between First and Second Streets.
8. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at First Street to the north-south alley located between First and Second Streets.
9. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at the north-south alley located between Main and First Streets, east to First Street.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance by parking contrary to the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall pay a fine of not less than \$2.00, nor more than \$500.00.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication as in the next section provided, and final passage.





ORDINANCE NO. 717

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 36, SECTION 67, CODE OF LAS VEGAS, 1949, BY PROVIDING FOR ALLEY PARKING WITHIN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 36, Section 67, Code of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1949, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 67. PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN ALLEYS.

When signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle at any time in the alley or portions thereof described in the following schedule:

1. On both sides of the north-south alley located between Fremont Street and Ogden Avenue, and between Main Street and First Street, from a point 30 feet south of the east-west alley in said block, to a point 75 feet north.

2. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden, commencing at the north-south alley located between Main Street and First Street, to a point 30 feet to the east.

3. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden, commencing at the north-south alley located between Main and First Streets east to Fourth Street.

4. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Ogden, commencing at Fourth Street east to Sixth Street.

5. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont Street and Carson Avenue commencing at Fourth Street east to Sixth Street.

6. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at Second Street east to Fourth Street.

7. On the south side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at Second Street to the north-south alley located between First and Second Streets.

8. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at First Street to the north-south alley located between First and Second Streets.

9. On the north side of the east-west alley located between Fremont and Carson, commencing at the north-south alley located between Main and First Streets east to First Street.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance by parking contrary to the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall pay a fine of not less than \$2.00, nor more than \$500.00.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication as in the next section provided, and final passage.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review-Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
