

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 564 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REFUSAL TO ISSUE BUSINESS LICENSES OR FOR THE REVOCATION OF BUSINESS LICENSES IN CERTAIN INSTANCES; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATED THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," BY PROVIDING FOR A MAJORITY VOTE BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR REVOCATION OR RENEWAL OF A BUSINESS LICENSE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 564 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any revocation of a business license, or failure to renew a business license as the case may be, shall be ordered only by the majority vote of the members of the Board of Commissioners present at the time when such matter was considered.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal Chapter 17, Section 19, Code of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1949, except as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, but all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. If any one or more sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance shall, for any reason, be questioned or held invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remaining provisions of this ordinance, but shall be confined in its operation to the specific sections, sentences, clauses or parts of this ordinance so held unconstitutional and invalid, and the inapplicability and invalidity of any section, sentence, clause or part of this ordinance, in any one or more instances shall not affect or prejudice in any way the applicability and validity of this ordinance in any other instances.

SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its final reading and adoption, and final publication as in the next section provided.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption in the Las Vegas Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.



BY PROVIDING FOR A MAJORITY VOTE BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS FOR REVOCATION OR RENEWAL OF A BUSINESS LICENSE; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.
