

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 312

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL ORDINANCE NO. 270 OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, DEFINING THE POWERS AND DUTIES THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATING THERETO."

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 270 of the City of Las Vegas, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, DEFINING THE POWERS AND DUTIES THEREOF AND MATTERS RELATING THERETO," and each and every part and provision thereof is hereby repealed.

Section 2. The City of Las Vegas having collaborated with the County of Clark, Nevada, and the City of North Las Vegas, Nevada, in the creation of a Regional Planning Commission, which is to function in the place and stead of the City Planning Commission heretofore created by Ordinance No. 270 of the City of Las Vegas, and the need for the future development of the City of Las Vegas being immediate and imperative, this ordinance is therefore declared to be and is hereby passed as an Emergency Ordinance and it shall take effect immediately after its passage and publication.

Section 3. The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to have this ordinance published in the Las Vegas Evening Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas, for a period of two weeks, that is to say: once each week.
