

ORDINANCE NO. 323

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND PROHIBIT THE SOLICITATION OF FUNDS IN THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND OTHER MATTER RELATING THERETO.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association or corporation to solicit funds or subscriptions or contributions or donations for any charitable, religious or fraternal purpose, or for any other purpose or cause in the City of Las Vegas, without first obtaining the permission of the Board of Commissioners of said City to so do.

Section 2. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be fined in the sum of not less than One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not more than thirty (30) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.


Section 3. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its publication, as in the next section provided, and final passage.

Section 5. The City Clerk and Clerk of the Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas shall cause this ordinance to be published once a week for two successive weeks immediately following its first reading and adoption, in the Las Vegas Evening Review Journal, a daily newspaper published in the City of Las Vegas.
