

ORDINANCE NO. 1500

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY ADDING CHAPTER 12 THERETO, TO PROVIDE THAT MUNICIPAL JUDGE MAY SUSPEND SENTENCES, GRANT PROBATION, GIVE CREDIT FOR TIME SERVED AND DISMISS CASES, TO IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM FOR REHABILITATION OF ALCOHOLICS AND PREVENTION OF ALCOHOLISM; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new chapter to be designated Chapter 12 to read as follows:

6-12 ALCOHOLICS

In order to implement the program to rehabilitate alcoholics and prevent alcoholism, as set forth in Title I, Chapter 10, Section 3 of this Code, the Municipal Judge may suspend sentences, grant probation, give credit for time served and dismiss cases, upon advice from the office of the Alcoholism Specialist that an offender is working with the Specialist and is participating in his program for rehabilitation of alcoholics and prevention of alcoholism.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


