

ORDINANCE NO. 1497

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 1, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, BY AMENDING SECTION 5 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO REQUIRE THAT A BICYCLE HAVE A FRAME NUMBER BEFORE BEING LICENSED; AND BY ADDING SECTION 22 TO SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF JUVENILE WARNING CITATIONS, MANDATORY ATTENDANCE AT BICYCLE SAFETY SCHOOL UPON RECEIPT OF THREE JUVENILE WARNING CITATIONS WITHIN A SIX-MONTH PERIOD AND SUSPENSION OF BICYCLE LICENSE PLATE UPON FAILURE TO ATTEND SAID SCHOOL; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 1, Section 5 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

10-1-5 ISSUANCE; RECORD: The Chief of Police, upon receiving proper application therefor, and a fee of fifty cents (50¢), shall be authorized to issue a bicycle license which shall be effective for the lifetime of the bicycle unless it is sooner traded, sold or otherwise disposed of, in which case the new owner shall renew the license the same as upon an original application. The Chief of Police shall not issue a license for any bicycle when he knows, or has reasonable ground to believe, that the applicant is not the owner of or entitled to the possession of such bicycle.

The Chief of Police shall keep a record of the number of each license, the date issued, the name and address of the person to whom issued, and the number on the frame of the bicycle for which issued. A license plate shall not be assigned to any bicycle which does not have a frame number.

SECTION 2. Title X, Chapter 1 of said Municipal Code is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section designated Section 22 to read as follows:

10-1-22 In addition to any other penalties provided in this Code,

a Juvenile Warning Citation may be issued to any juvenile for any violation of the provisions of this Chapter.

If a juvenile receives three (3) Juvenile Warning Citations within a six (6) month period, the Chief of Police shall cause a notice to be given to said juvenile requiring him to attend Bicycle Safety School at a time and place to be set forth in said notice.

The fee to attend said Bicycle Safety School shall be \$5.00, which said fee must be paid by the juvenile or his parent at the time the juvenile attends the School.


In the event that a juvenile who has been notified to attend Bicycle Safety School fails to attend the same at the time and place specified, then the Chief of Police shall suspend the bicycle license plate of said juvenile until he attends said School.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

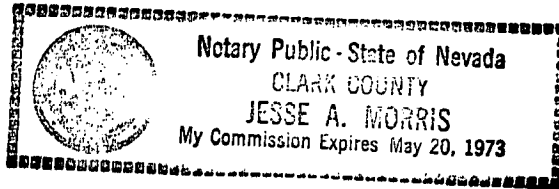

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE CHAPTER 15 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1970 EDITION, BY AMENDING SECTION 5 OF SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER TO REQUIRE THAT A BICYCLE HAVE A FRAME NUMBER BEFORE BEING LICENSED; AMENDING SECTION 22 TO SAID TITLE AND CHAPTER, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF JUVENILE WARNING CITATIONS, MANDATORY ATTENDANCE AT BICYCLE SAFETY SCHOOL UPON RECEIPT OF THREE JUVENILE WARNING CITATIONS WITHIN A SIX-MONTH PERIOD AND SUSPENSION OF BICYCLE LICENSE PLATE UPON FAILURE TO ATTEND SAID SCHOOL; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.
