

ORDINANCE NO. 1488

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE I, CHAPTER 18 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE AMENDMENTS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS TO THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, COUNTY OF CLARK, STATE OF NEVADA, FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF SAID CITY; TO AMEND SECTION 350.3 TO PROVIDE THAT PROMOTIONAL LISTS ARE ONLY GOOD FOR ONE YEAR; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH. 1488

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title I, Chapter 18, Section 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-18-2: AMENDMENTS: Certain sections of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations of the City of Las Vegas are hereby deleted, modified, amended, repealed or added to, as follows, to wit:

Section 350.3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

350.3: Eligible lists resulting from a promotional examination shall remain in effect for one year from date of certification. Eligible lists resulting from an open competitive examination shall remain in effect for six months from date of certification, provided, however, that in cases in which both an open competitive examination and a promotional examination have been given for the same classification, as provided in Rule 350.1 (g), the eligible list established as the result of open competitive examination shall remain in effect for ninety (90) days from date of certification. Eligible lists resulting from an examination held for persons employed by the City on a temporary basis through federally funded poverty programs shall remain in effect for one month from date of certification.

Eligible lists resulting from an open competitive examination or an examination held for persons employed by the City on a temporary basis through federally funded poverty programs may be extended by the Civil Service Board at the request of the Personnel Director and approval of the City Manager for an additional period, not to exceed six (6) months.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, sentences, clauses or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

An ordinance to amend Title I, Chapter 18 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, adopting by reference amendments, changes and additions to the Civil Service rules and regulations of the City of Las Vegas, County of Clark, State of Nevada, for the employees of said city; to amend Section 350.3 to provide that promotional lists are only good for one year; providing other matters properly relating thereto; providing penalties for the violation hereof; and repealing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith.

The Board of Commissioners of the City of Las Vegas does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Title I, Chapter 18, Section 2 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1-18-2: AMENDMENTS: Certain sections of the Civil Service Rules and Regulations of the City of Las Vegas are hereby deleted, modified, amended, repealed or added to, as follows, to wit:

Section 350.3 is hereby amended to read as follows:

350.3: Eligible lists resulting from a promotional examination shall remain in effect for one year from date of certification. Eligible lists resulting from an open competitive examination shall remain in effect for six months from date of certification, provided, however, that in cases in which both an open competitive examination and a promotional examination have been given for the same classification, as provided in Rule 350.1 (g), the eligible list established as the result of open competitive examination shall remain in effect for ninety (90) days from date of certification. Eligible lists resulting from an examination held for persons employed by the City on a temporary basis through federally funded poverty programs shall remain in effect for one month from date of certification.

Eligible lists resulting from an open competitive examination or an examination held for persons employed by the City on a temporary basis through federally funded poverty programs may be extended by the Civil Service Board at the request of the Personnel Director, and approval of the City Manager for an additional period, not to exceed six (6) months.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six (6) months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.
