

ORDINANCE NO. 1442

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE VI, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO ADD A NEW DEFINITION, TO WIT, "DOG FANCIER"; TO AMEND TITLE VI, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 2, SUBSECTION (B) OF SAID MUNICIPAL CODE TO PROVIDE THAT DOG FANCIERS MAY MAINTAIN UP TO SIX DOGS UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS; PROVIDING OTHER MATTERS PROPERLY RELATING THERETO; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title VI, Chapter 2, Section 1 of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

A "dog fancier" is a person owning or keeping on his property at one location up to six adult dogs for the purpose of showing in recognized dog shows, field trials or obedience trials, for working and hunting, or for improving the variety or breed in temperament or conformation with a view to exhibition in shows or trials or for use as working dogs in hunting.

SECTION 2. Title VI, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection (B) of said Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

6-2-2: (B) Keeping of Dogs or Cats. No person shall keep more than three (3) canine animals over six (6) months of age, nor more than three (3) cats over three (3) months of age, at any place, or on any premises, or in any one residence, located within and under the jurisdiction of the City, within two hundred feet (200') of any other dwelling house, used or occupied by human beings, other than the owner of such dogs or cats, without first obtaining a permit from the City therefor, but said permit, in exercise of sound discretion and for good cause shown, may be refused. If granted, such permit shall be on such conditions as may be deemed necessary or advisable and as prescribed by the Health Officer to prevent the keeping of any and all such animals from becoming a nuisance; provided, however, that a dog fancier may keep and maintain on his property up to but no more than six (6) adult dogs over

the age of one (1) year, provided the said owner first obtains from the Director of License and Revenue a special permit for each of the said adult dogs at an annual license fee of Four Dollars (\$4.00) per dog. All dog fanciers meeting the provisions of this subsection and having in their possession for each adult dog a special permit as described herein need not have the property where the dogs are so maintained rezoned.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses, or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

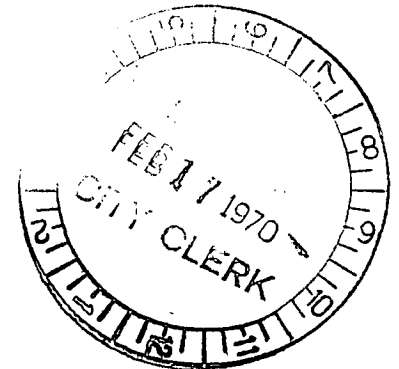

All dog fanciers meeting the provisions of this subsection and having in their possession for each adult dog a special permit as described herein need not have the property where the dogs are so maintained rezoned.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses, or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
