

ORDINANCE NO. 1440

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE X, CHAPTER 10, SECTION 5, SUBSECTION C, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS, NEVADA, 1960 EDITION, TO PROVIDE THAT VEHICULAR TRAFFIC FACING A RED OR "STOP" SIGNAL MAY PROCEED THROUGH THE INTERSECTION WHEN SUCH SIGNAL TURNS TO GREEN, FLASHING YELLOW OR FLASHING RED.

THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF LAS VEGAS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Title X, Chapter 10, Section 5, Subsection C of the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, is hereby amended to read as follows:


- 10-10-5 (C):
1. Vehicular traffic facing the signal shall stop at a limit line, if marked, otherwise before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, if none, then before entering the intersection and shall remain standing until green or "Go" is shown alone or until flashing yellow or flashing red is shown alone.
  2. The driver of a vehicle which is stopped as close as practicable at the entrance to the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none, then at the entrance to the intersection in obedience to a red or "Stop" signal may make a right turn except where prohibited by sign, but shall yield the right-of-way to pedestrians and other traffic proceeding as directed by the signal at such intersection.
  3. No pedestrian facing such signal shall enter the roadway until the green or "Go" is shown unless authorized so to do by a pedestrian "Walk" signal.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 and/or imprisonment in the city jail for not more than six months, or any combination of such fine and imprisonment. Every day of such violation shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances, sections, subsections, phrases, clauses, or paragraphs contained in the Municipal Code of the City of Las Vegas, Nevada, 1960 Edition, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


